Grants totaling \$54K:

- Telstra grant to build a website for Burren - <https://burrenjunction.com/>
- Burren switched on Grant - internet connectivity at the hall - Starlink is installed as well as a Smart TV for meetings and a drop-down screen for film nights
- GrainCorp grant for container to house gear from Smoker's Room
- Shire Grant for concrete around hall, gravel, sand and air condition Smoker's room for Museum
- Landcare grant to eradicate Indian Myna birds
- Shire Grant for walking history tour of the township

Ongoing working with Shire over:

- Pilliga road upgrade and other roads in and around Burren
- Airstrip upgrade
- development of the Sports Precinct,
- maintenance of the bore baths and a possible walking track into town from the bore.
- a designated truck stop in Burren with facilities
- drainage in the township
- School Crossing out the front of the school
- Pool Upgrade
- New town signage welcoming visitors to our town.
